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General issues. My academic mobility took place from 20.05.2024 to 24.05.2024 in University of West Attica (UNIWA), Greece.

Overall objectives of the mobility are delivering courses (8 teaching hours) to the students of the Receiving Institution, Meetings and discussions with the colleagues from Department of Surveying and Geoinformatics Engineering about exchange of experience in the teaching process, main line of further cooperation, possible projects etc.

- Erasmus+ office visit. Meeting with the Mobility Coordinator Mrs. Fani Papoutsi (Programme expansion considerations, Student and Staff mobility preparations and next steps etc.)

Beside this every day I had Discussions with students (usually it took place after each lecture) and Meetings and discussions with the colleagues from Department of Surveying and Geoinformatics Engineering about possibility of organizing joint scientific conferences, possibility of joint scientific publications and others forms of further collaboration.
