# The first meeting – will be held in Campus Egaleo Park.

Where: UNIVERSITY OF WEST ATTICA - Campus Egaleo (Aigaleo) Park or Campus 1.

Adress: Agiou Spiridonos - Egaleo.

**Meeting Point:** Building K-1. Ground floor – Erasmus+ Office

**Tip:** Please count approximately one hour from the place of stay (especially if you are staying in the city center) to reach the campus for the first time (maybe more).

## **Instructions about reaching Campus 1.**

### PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

#### **CAMPUS EGALEO PARK**

From Metro station EGALEO (or AIGALEO) -blue line - direction Dimotiko Theatro.

## On Egaleo Square there are many bus stations.

Please get into **829** and reach UNIWA **after 7 stops** (the bus is named TEI A $\Theta$ HNA $\Sigma$  - is the former name of the University).

5 minutes' walk from the stop is the main gate.



*Inside the metro you can find information of the directions and the specific times of arrival (metro trains run every 3 to 5 minutes).* 

## • TICKETS

- 1. The normal ticket costs 1.20 euro (valid for 1 hour and 30 minutes for all public means). I would recommend a monthly ticket, for all public transportation means into Athens.
- 2. The ticket is valid for all Athens Urban Transport Organization means: buses, trolley-buses, trams and metro lines 1, 2 and 3) networks and for the Suburban Railway (TRAINOSE)Valid for 5 X 24 hours from its first validation. This ticket type is **not valid** for the Airport.
- 3. Athens Metro Airport Tickets are valid for all Athens Urban Transport Organization (OASA) means, for 90 minutes from their first validation, at any blue ticket reader on metro station gate, bus, trolleybus or tramway (cost 9.00 euro for single ride) The two-way Metro Airport Ticket is valid for a journey from and to the Airport. Its validity lasts 30 days. The same tickets are also valid for Suburban Railway (TRAINOSE). **9.00** euro one-way ticket.
- 4. A two-way metro airport ticket costs 16.00 euro (but please check its validity if you purchase it early)

# • IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. All Erasmus members can have lunch and dinner at the University's Restaurants with a dining cost of 4.00 euro (this is a special fixed price for Professors and Staff). Each meal includes a starter meal, salad, main dish, fruits/sweets/delights and water. The lunch receipt can be used as a permission for dinner, without any extra charge.
- 2. For Students, three free meals are offered as far as the Erasmus Office have given the list with the incoming students. Whenever you will receive your student Id card you just use it to all restaurants as an authentication.
- 3. Last but not least, please <u>be aware of your personal belongings</u> downtown Athens and <u>inside the transportation</u>, especially to busy crowded places. <u>Be extremely careful</u> with your belongings in the train and metro stations, especially in Monastiraki, Peireaus, Omonoia, Syggrou areas and downtown Plaka- Ancient Athens. The areas are "DOs" to visit (they are the most famous and crowded places apart from Syggrou and Omonoia DONTs).

Backpacks are not recommended unless you're super careful with your bags.
