Payment Breakdown

All PhD students will receive:

- ▶ 70 EUR per day (for 5+2 days)
- plus 275 EUR travel grant (constant amount)

All staff members will receive:

- > 160 EUR per day
- 275 EUR travel grant (constant amount)

Visa, insurance, accommodation costs are not covered by the programme.

- √ 80% before the mobility
- ✓ 20% after the mobility
