REGISTRATION	The registration procedure will be held by the Erasmus Office in coordination with the Secretariat of each student's Department, as long as they have submitted the original registration documents (Identity Card or Passport, European Health Insurance Card).
SYSTEM OF STUDY COURSES	The basic unit of a study program is a course. A typical course consists of a series of lectures and/or an assignment/project.
GRADING SYSTEM	Hellenic grading system is based on a 1 to 10 scale: Less than 5 — FAIL You can find more information in the following link: https://erasmus.uniwa.gr/en/f-a-q/
CREDIT SYSTEM	The University of West Attica has completely adopted the ECTS credit system. The estimated workload for full time students in one academic year is 60 ECTS credits, meaning 30 ECTS credits per semester and 20 ECTS credits for a three-month period.

STUDENT FEES	Erasmus students are not charged tuition fees.
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	English: B.2 The main language of instruction at UNIWA is Greek, but there are also many courses available in English.
ACCOMMODATION	The University of West Attica does not offer accommodation facilities. The students are expected to arrange accommodation by themselves, in accordance with their personal preferences. It is advisable that the students should also address the ESN (European Student Network) of West Attica for help and support.
