<b>REGISTRATION</b>	The registration procedure will be held by the Erasmus Office in coordination with the Secretariat of each student's Department, as long as they have submitted the original registration documents (Identity Card or Passport, European Health Insurance Card).
<b>SYSTEM OF STUDY COURSES</b>	The basic unit of a study program is a course. A typical course consists of a series of lectures and/or an assignment/project.

<b>CREDIT SYSTEM</b>	The University of West Attica has completely adopted the ECTS credit system. The estimated workload for full time students in one academic year is 60 ECTS credits, meaning 30 ECTS credits per semester and 20 ECTS credits for a three-month period.

<b>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS</b>	English: B.2 The main language of instruction at UNIWA is Greek, but there are also many courses available in English.

The students are expected to arrange accommodation by themselves, in accordance with their personal preferences.
